TIMMINS, ON – February 17, 2006 – Cellular service in Northeastern Ontario has made great strides over the last few years, due in part to the completion of Phase 1 of NEOnet's cellular expansion project. New cellular towers were constructed providing 90% coverage to 540 kms of Northern Ontario highways, however there remains a need for further expansion and devices that boost cellular signals. A variety of signal boosting devices are available for use at home, cottage or in the car.
